The course starts on Saturday 23rd May 2009 from 9am until 6pm daily. The course finishes on Friday 29th May (excludes Monday 25th May, Bank Holiday). Candidates must attend all sessions. Assessments will be scheduled during the course. The course costs £250 and includes all assessment fees, manuals and lunch daily.

Conditions

1. All medical conditions must be declared on the form below. Certain medical conditions may restrict the ability of the candidate to pass the qualification.
2. Candidates will be required to dive to the deepest part of the pool as part of the course (2.5 metres). Diving to depths deeper than 1.5 metres can harm your hearing and candidates are reminded that all such dives are done at their own risk.
3. Goggles are permitted during training but NOT during the assessment. Candidates should be aware of the risks with use and non-use of goggles.
4. All items of jewellery must be removed prior to training sessions. Wedding rings, religious tokens, medical items etc are at the trainers' discretion.
5. You must be 16 years of age or older on the day the course starts.
6. You must be able to meet the prerequisites stated in the Course Info provided.
