## LOCAL RULES

### STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)

- A ball coming to rest on any artificially surfaced path, track or road, on exposed drainage lines and on sleepered bridges may be lifted and dropped without penalty.
- A ball coming to rest near any staked or wired tree and within any fenced area of trees must be lifted and dropped without penalty.
- All fixed sprinkler heads and covers associated with the irrigation system are immovable obstructions and relief without penalty may be obtained. If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which is not nearer the hole, avoids such intervention and is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

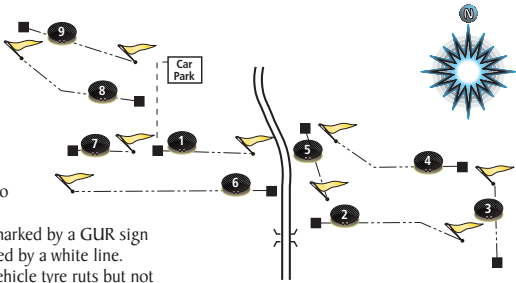
### GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)

Relief may be taken if a ball comes to rest in:

- An area marked by a GUR sign or surrounded by a white line.
- Tractor/vehicle tyre ruts but not including faint tyre marks.
- An Animal scrape.
- Unrepaired course work.

### WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

As defined by yellow posts or markings or, in the case of lateral water hazards, red posts or markings. The ditch/stream crossing the 2nd and 4th fairways is a water hazard and the ditch/stream to the left of the 2nd fairway, to the left and right of the 4th fairway, to the right of and beyond the 3rd green and beyond the 5th green are lateral water hazards.



If a ball comes to rest in the lateral water hazards adjacent to the 3rd and 5th greens, the player must, under penalty of one stroke, drop a ball in the nearest Dropping Zone to where the ball crossed the line of the hazard.

### OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

Beyond any fence, hedge or wall bounding the course or as marked by a line of posts with white bands.
